Job Description

The duties of Organizer include the following, at the direction and under the supervision of the Lead Organizer:

- Research potential organizing targets.
- Develop and maintain effective communication networks.
- Visit potential members at their homes to discuss the benefits of unionization.
- Create and maintain lists and charts, including the use of computerized database systems.
- Collect target data and information.
- Prepare and present clear, concise, and complete verbal and written reports.
- Recruit new members.
- Identify potential activists and provide resources and mentoring to support organizing campaigns.

- Develop flyers, posters, buttons, slogans, and other campaign related materials and items.
- Provide COMET training to members.
- Maintain an up-to-date knowledge of the National Labor Relations Act and important case law, and attend training as directed.

The requirements of the job are as follows:

- 1. Must be willing to travel as necessary.
- 2. Knowledge of social media such as Facebook, X (formerly Twitter), Instagram, and Snapchat.
- 3. Ability to text and group text.
- 4. Must have a good driving record.
- 5. Must have good communication skills.
- 6. Must have good leadership skills and the ability to motivate others.
- 7. Must be a self-starter.
- 8. Must be willing to apply and work at non-union shops as a salt.
- 9. Must be willing to be away from home for extended periods of time as needed.
- 10. Must be able to pass a background check (driving record, criminal convictions, verification of educational background, work history and social security number).
- 11. Must be able to pass a drug test.
- 12. Willing to work nights/weekends/holidays as necessary.
