JAMES (KENNY) MOORE SCHOLARSHIP FUND
SUMMARY OF BENEFITS

I. ELIGIBILITY A child of an eligible employee shall be eligible to receive a scholarship under this plan as awarded by the Executive Board of Sprinkler Fitters Local 821. A child means a natural born or adopted child of an employee who is under the age of 24, who resides with the employee or is dependent upon the employee for support. An employee becomes an eligible employee under this program at the end of the second year following the completion of at least five hundred (500) hours of employment for an employer who has a collective bargaining agreement with the union. An employee remains an eligible employee until the employee has less than two hundred fifty (250) hours of employment for an employer with a collective bargaining agreement with the union in the plan year. In the event of the death or retirement of an eligible employee, the child shall remain eligible for scholarship consideration for twenty four (24) months after the employee's death or retirement. Only children of eligible employees, who have already completed a minimum of twenty four (24) credit hours in the previous school year, with a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 in a College or University as described below, may receive a benefit under this scholarship plan.

II. HOW ARE SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED Scholarships are awarded by the Executive Board of Local 821 based on available resources. Prior to the announcement of availability of scholarships, you will receive a letter from the executive board informing eligible employees that the scholarships will be available.

III. SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION At the time that scholarships are made available, you will also receive from the Executive Board a notice describing how scholarships will be selected among the children of the eligible employees. This notice will also advise of any minimum requirements necessary to maintain a scholarship and how the scholarship will be paid. Scholarships may be paid directly to the College or University on behalf of the child, or directly to the employee or directly to the child. Scholarship availability notice will be sent to the employee requesting it by the end of each June, and must be returned to Local 821 by the last working day of August, for consideration and award at our September meeting.

IV. COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY The term "College" or "University" means any federal, state, parochial church or private educational institution, which provides a program of education beyond high school. This program must provide for regular classes and courses of study, which are required for eligibility to or certification of a Bachelor's Degree or higher or provides a program, which is acceptable for full credit towards such a degree.

V. Administration The Executive Board of Local 821 administers the Sprinkler Fitters Local 821 James (Kenny) Moore Scholarship Fund. The Executive Board in their sole discretion will determine all questions concerning the scholarship. In the event that the Executive Board denies in whole or any part of this benefit provided to you, you have the right to request a review of the Executive Boards decision. A written notice of such a request must be submitted to the Executive Board of Local 821 within sixty (60) days after the denial of your request. This notice should briefly describe the grounds upon which you appeal and be signed by the eligible party.

VI. Amendment The Executive Board of Local 821 may amend the scholarship plan at any time.
